

**Proposition 136**  
**Ballot Measures; Challenges**  
**Fiscal Analysis**

**Estimated Impact**

Proposition 136 would allow a person to challenge the constitutionality of a proposed initiative measure in the Superior Court as long as the action is brought at least 100 days prior to the election. The proposition would also allow any person to appeal to the Arizona Supreme Court within 5 days after the Superior Court enters its judgment.

The proposition may increase judicial costs to adjudicate challenges to ballot propositions. The Secretary of State may also have legal expenses if they are part of any judicial filings. These fiscal impacts will depend on the number of challenges and cannot be determined in advance. We expect that any costs would be minimal.
