

**Proposition 137
Judicial Retention Elections
Fiscal Analysis**

Estimated Impact

Proposition 137 would eliminate specified term lengths for justices and judges of the Arizona Supreme Court, Court of Appeals, and the Superior Court in counties with a population of at least 250,000 and also the associated requirement that justices and judges seek retention election at the end of those terms and instead allow justices and judges to hold office indefinitely as long as they remain in good behavior.

The proposition could reduce county costs to the extent that these changes to judicial retention elections reduce the length of election ballots.
